PROGRAM TRIP TO CAMBODIA

In November, Executive Director Chris Bombardier and Program Manager Jenn Brockway-Peirce visited Cambodia. Chris and Jenn spent time with both the Phnom Penh and Siem Reap chapters, and they were welcomed into the homes of 14 Save One Life beneficiaries. They heard first-hand how much the sponsorship funds are needed and the many ways the funds have helped improve their lives.



SPONSORSHIP HIGHLIGHT

In July, the entire Save One Life team virtually attended an Awareness Event hosted by the Hemophilia Foundation of Pakistan, Lahore Chapter. This event, for beneficiaries and their families, was an opportunity to provide education and distribute sponsorship funds to beneficiaries.

We heard from Sadia, who thanked Save One Life for the support she received. It allowed her the opportunity to complete high school and her Bachelor of Science in Nursing. Now a staff nurse and independent professional woman, she is able to effectively cope with her bleeding disorder. She comes from an underprivileged family, and it was difficult for her father to support Sadia's education on his own.



MICRO-ENTERPRISE GRANTS HIGHLIGHT

Christian, a young man with hemophilia A from the Democratic Republic of Congo, currently lives in the Nakivale Refugee Camp in Uganda. He started a small studio where he sells movies and music, offers printing services, repairs computers and installs software.

With the help of a Save One Life Micro-Enterprise grant, Christian expanded his business to provide additional income for his family, including four of his siblings who also have hemophilia. The Micro-Enterprise grant has had a big impact on this family.



SCHOLARSHIP HIGHLIGHT

In 2022, Adrian Vaduva is in his final year of medical school. He has been a beneficiary of the Save One Life sponsorship program since he was 10 years old.





I am in my final year of medical school and you have been a very important part of my journey.

When I started receiving the sponsorship I was going through a very rough time. My mother, a single parent with no income, was trying to turn our life around by attending college at 35 years old while trying to raise me the best she could. Your help...gave me the stepping stone I needed to start believing I can become whatever I want because there would always be help along the way.

I really want to express my gratitude for everything you have done for me and for what it meant to have a helping hand always reached out to me during my years of study.

PROJECT SHARE HIGHLIGHT



Taochan, from The Philippines, was hospitalized in May 2022 after a severe bleed from his Covid vaccine. Thanks to Project SHARE and the access to treatment, Taochan now lives a normal life. He does well in school and his teachers praise his positive outlook on life.

TRIP TO BURUNDI

In July, Chris traveled with the French Hemophilia Association (AHF) on their first visit to Burundi. He was joined by Thomas Sannié and Dr. Philippe De Moerloose, who have been working to bring better bleeding disorder care to French speaking African countries since 2014.

In Burundi, treatment of bleeding disorders is nonexistent. The few patients they met traveled to Rwanda to confirm their diagnosis. Several years ago, a father, Gilbert, brought his son to Rwanda for exactly that. His trip to Rwanda led to the creation of the first bleeding disorder patient organization in Burundi. Unfortunately, Gilbert's son passed away. Despite this loss, Gilbert was passionate to ensure that others in Burundi didn't experience what he and his son did.



Chris watched Thomas and Dr. de Moerloose as they trained health care professionals and patients about their conditions. Many of the health care professionals and patients had never heard of hemophilia but welcomed the information, excited to learn how they could improve bleeding disorder health care in their country. Felix is a patient that especially stood out. He was a bleeding disorder advocate who educated himself through his own research online.


THE HISTORY




Wheels for the World has continued to bring awareness to Save One Life and raise desperately needed funding for our programs.
