





PROVIDING ACCESS TO INCOME

Our Micro-Enterprise Grants (MEGs) make it possible for adults with bleeding disorders to start a small business. People with bleeding disorders in developing countries are often disabled due to a lack of access to treatment. This can prevent them from employment in traditional manual-labor jobs. MEGs allow these families to have a consistent source of income within their capabilities. We also grant MEGs to parents of children with bleeding disorders. They often must take days off from work to care for their child when they have a bleed. By starting their own businesses, parents have the income and flexibility to care for their children.

HISTORY


Save One Life created the Micro-Enterprise Grant (MEG) Program in 2014 to help patients and families with bleeding disorders in developing countries create small businesses. Funding for the program has historically come from general fundraisers. In 2019, Save One Life partnered with Roche/Genentech to expand the program reach through consistent funding.

Since 2014, Save One Life has provided 301 microenterprise grants in 13 countries.


Micro-Enterprise Grants Awarded by Country (PPO)

OUR IMPACT: MIRZA

PAKISTAN



This is Mirza, who received a micro-enterprise grant to open a garment shop in Karachi to sell children's clothing. Mirza is doing very well.

Mirza was a sponsorship beneficiary from 2013 to 2021, which was immensely helpful to his family on maintaining financial stability and care for his bleeding disorder. Mirza and his father were the primary breadwinners for the family until 2016 when Mirza's father unfortunately became paralyzed. Since his father was paralyzed, Mirza became the only means of financial support for the family. He applied for a MEG to open a food stand, which he was granted. Shortly after, he changed his business model to sell clothes since he had a better understanding of the market.

Now, Mirza's business is thriving. He found the perfect location within a busy market known for garments. His shop may be small, but it is well organized and vibrantly decorated. Mirza has one employee currently and can easily pay his salary each month. His most profitable times are during the holidays, such as Ramadan. Then, he is able to save money in hopes of expanding his shop to sell more than just children's clothes in the future.

OUR IMPACT: SUBHANKAR





This is Subhankar, who received a micro-enterprise grant to start his own blood collection laboratory. Before he was awarded this grant, his family struggled to maintain income for basic needs. Subhankar's mother is a homemaker and his father is paralyzed. Now, his business is doing well and he is able to care for his family. Also, He is passionate about helping the poor, and gives special discounts to those in need. Subhankar's income has doubled so far, and he is confident in expanding his business in the near future!

WOMEN IN BUSINESS: INDIA



Archana received a MEG to open a jewelry business, which has become successful. Archana was able to save money for her son with hemophilia to pursue higher education. She is confident she will do the same for her other two children as well. Also, Archana saved enough money to donate a new sewing machine for someone in her chapter, to give back to her community.



Selma received a MEG to improve her sewing business. Prior to the grant, she was struggling to make a living as a single mom. Now, she earns enough to support her family and employ two women, who help her with stitching. She is very proud that she was able to achieve this, give employment to two women, and gain confidence as a single mom.



Anita received a MEG to improve her eatery.

Customer's give positive reviews about her food and kind nature. Notably that she is willing to feed those in need, free of cost. Also, the food is delicious. Anita shared that this MEG has greatly improved her life. She is able to save money for her children and their treatment, while also paying for their school!



Manasi received a MEG to start a small business, selling marriage bangles and children's dresses. Prior to receiving the grant, it was difficult for her to earn an income as she had to care for her husband and son with hemophilia. Now, her small business is doing well, lightening the financial stress on the family. She is able to use the income to pay for her son's treatment.
