COVID-19'S **IMPACT: BRIAN'S STORY**

The global pandemic has had a profound impact on the families Save One Life supports. Most families have experienced some sort of lockdown, which meant their already minimal incomes were reduced to nothing.

Brian, who lives about two hours from Nairobi, Kenya, shared his story with us. In March, heavy rains caused devastation. Brian's home was flooded and his family's crops, house, bedding, and clothing were all destroyed. A neighbor took the family in until their



house was clear of standing water. Brian's parents work as laborers on local farms, but fear of the virus had closed many farms. The parents lost their entire income. The family has now planted new crops on their own land. They are unable to sell these crops for income as they will use them to feed the family.

Without Save One Life's sponsorship program, Brian's family would not be able to afford basic necessities. This program is Brian's safety net, especially during tough times.

2020 HIGHLIGHTS

1. CATALYST LEADERSHIP INITIATIVE

Since 1996, Laurie Kelley, founder of Save One Life, has been identifying leaders in developing countries to help build and grow patient-led bleeding disorder organizations. She has spent countless hours mentoring these new leaders. Laurie's goal was to eventually have these organizations register with their local governments and the World Federation of Hemophilia (WFH).

In 2020, Bayer Healthcare provided a grant to formalize this program through Save One Life. Before COVID-19 struck, the focus was on developing patient organizations in Rwanda, Fiji and Haiti. Although travel was greatly BAYER restricted, progress has been made in all three countries. Funded by

2. AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

The Ambassador Program encourages volunteers in the US to advocate, educate and fundraise on behalf of Save One Life. The goal is to develop a network of ambassadors to raise awareness of the drastic disparity in care for the bleeding disorder community in developing countries. Funded by Novo Nordisk.

3. SCHOLARSHIPS PROGRAM

Since 2012, Save One Life has provided 335 scholarships to 193 students in 10 countries. In 2020, Save One Life awarded scholarships to 28 individuals in seven countries. The average scholarship was \$825. Funded by Sanofi Genzyme.



4. MICRO-ENTERPRISE GRANT PROGRAM

Since 2014, Save One Life has provided 144 grants in 13 countries. Despite the impact of COVID-19 in 2020, Save One Life was able to award 32 micro-enterprise grants (MEG). The average grant was \$928. Funded by Roche/Genentech.



5. PROJECT SHARE (SUPPLYING HEMOPHILIA AID AND RELIEF)

Project SHARE ensures that tens of millions of dollars worth of unwanted and unused factor, which would otherwise be destroyed, reaches impoverished people with bleeding disorders. In 2020, Project SHARE shipped over 18 million IU of factor and 464 mg of bypassing agent to 28 countries. Thanks to all those who donated factor or provided financial support to Project SHARE. Funded by Takeda and Octapharma.



BOMBARDIER BLOOD WIDELY DISTRIBUTED

The film received great reviews from critics and has raised awareness of Save One Life and its work to improve the lives of people living with bleeding disorders in developing countries. WHEELS FOR THE WORLD REIMAGINED

Due to COVID-19, Wheels for the World became a hybrid event. Thanks to many corporate sponsors, riders, and all who fundraised, this virtual event raised over \$58,000! Cyclists rode indoors, on the road and in the woods. Participants cycled in Germany, the UK, Florida, Alaska, California and more. Over 27 cyclists raised more than \$250; four raised over \$1,000!



Wheels for the World started in 2012 when Barry Haarde, a cyclist with hemophilia and HIV, inspired people with and without a bleeding disorder by cycling across the country six times in six years, raising over \$250,000 for Save One Life. After he passed away suddenly in 2018, this community ride was formed to continue Barry's contribution to Save One Life and to encourage healthy and active living.





















Over the summer, William Addison, an outdoor enthusiast with hemophilia, undertook the impressive task of hiking the South Bound (SOBO) route of the Appalachian Trail. William used his hike to raise awareness and funds for Save One Life.

His initial goal was \$2,200—one dollar per mile. Within a few weeks William surpassed that and raised over \$27,000 for Save One Life!

seven-hour FaceBook Live Q&A with partners and friends that have shown support throughout the year. Questions and comments came from around the world and several beneficiaries received sponsorships.




AT HOME EVEREST CHALLENGE

A national quarantine left many people stuck at home; remaining active was difficult. The At Home Everest Challenge encouraged people to move while raising awareness and support for Save One Life. Coinciding with the third anniversary of Chris Bombardier's summit of Mt. Everest (elevation 29,029 feet), participants were encouraged to climb 29 flights of stairs, donate \$29 and challenge nine friends to do the same. Videos were shared by many around the globe and the event raised over \$15,000.

FIELD VISITS

RWANDA

In late February, Laurie Kelley visited Rwanda for the third time in six years, to participate in a clinic diagnosis day and a separate educational day, organized by the French Hemophilia Association (AFH). Six years ago, Laurie helped a group of patients in Rwanda to found the Rwanda Fraternity Against Hemophilia (RFH).

AFH medical volunteer Dr. Marc Trossaert and Rwandan pediatric hematologist Dr. Aimable Kanyamuhunga of Children's Hospital University of Kigali (CHUK) conducted patient screenings and blood tests on 50 patients. French volunteers François Sauvêtre and Brigitte Albert constructed patient pedigrees. The next day, about 60 families and rural healthcare workers attended a symposium to learn about symptoms and transmission of hemophilia. Later, Laurie and the team were interviewed by reporters about the visit, which was aired on national television that night. A final success of the trip was the news that the RFH was legally registered as a nonprofit the following week.






